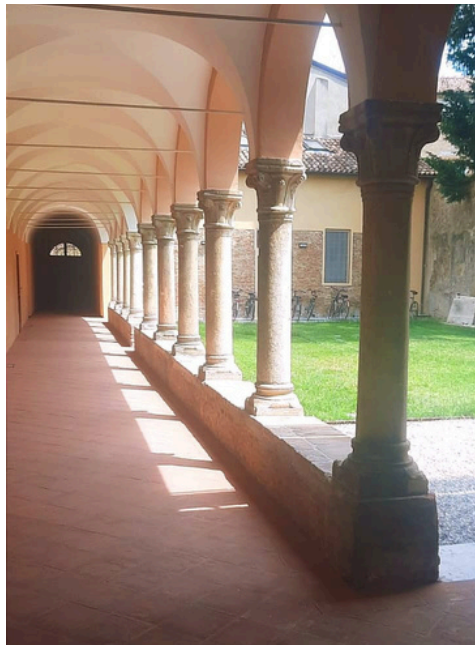

- c) Research and experimentation linked to the theme of the inclusion of young people in **active life**;

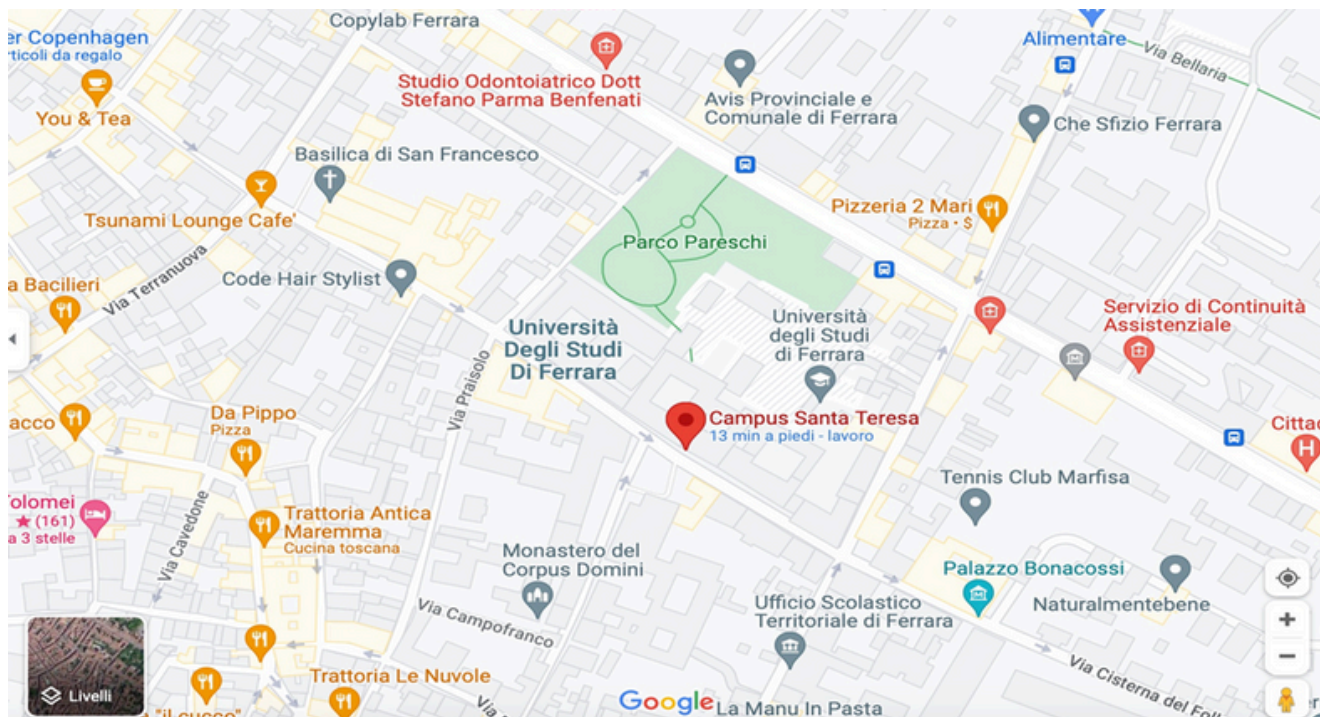
This competition notice concerns the university facility Campus Santa Teresa, located at p.tta Giovanni da Tossignano 2 - 44121 Ferrara (FE) managed by the Enrico Zanotti Foundation and funded by the European Union - "NextGenerationEU" referred to in the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR) - Mission 4 - Component 1 - Reform 1.7 "Student Housing and Student Housing Legislation Reform".

AREAS

The structure offers single or double rooms and presents outdoor and indoor common spaces that allow students to live in an environment that encourages conviviality and socialization. At the same time, it provides private spaces for study and rest.

Common Spaces	Description
Study Rooms	2 Study rooms equipped with workstation and internet access. 1 room is equipped with a library available to students
Common kitchens	3 Communal kitchens for the preparation of meals
Common dining room	1 Dining room for meals
Multipurpose room	Cultural and recreational area (equipped with audio-video equipment)
Outdoor areas	2 external gardens located inside the structure. The areas are available for convivial, socializing and study activities. There is a large terrace where you can study or use as a refreshment area

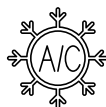

EDUCATIONAL PROJECT

The Campus Santa Teresa enriches the university study path with a 50-hour annual educational project **signed by the student** at the beginning of the Academic Year. On Campus the growth path develops in an international study-friendly environment, in a climate of dialogue and freedom. All this is favored by a **continuous educational relationship** with international teachers and tutors who will accompany the student both in the context of cultural insight and in the **introduction to the world of work**.

This model is designed together with each student and will synergistically propose **cultural appointments and personalized paths** so that the student can discover skills and potential in line with the chosen study plan and suited to university commitments. The cultural meetings are part of the «ACCADEMIA – Con il Cuore indiviso» project (<https://www.fondazionezanotti.org/universita/accademia/>) which offers a structured, modular and open path composed of interdisciplinary courses and thematic insights with teachers and personalities of national and international importance capable of generating relationships and knowledge aimed at **broadening the horizons** of the participants. The path will be monitored together with the educational manager through interviews during the stay on the Santa Teresa Campus. Thanks to collaborations with national and international organizations and institutions, the student is placed in a **wide-ranging context that generates opportunities**.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

This competition notice is for students who in the a.y. 2025/2026 :

- Enroll/are enrolled in any university-level school or institute
- Have no criminal convictions and have no pending charges
- Are free from pathologies incompatible with community life

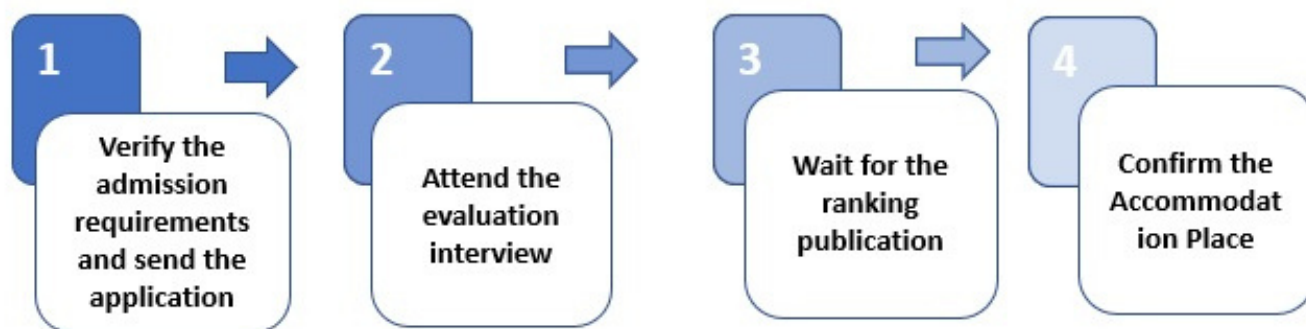
For students enrolled in years subsequent to the first year in the a.y. 2025/2026:

- University curriculum with an arithmetic average grade equal to or higher than 24/30 (rounded to the nearest integer)

The lack of one or more requirements leads to the inadmissibility of the application.

ADMISSION

The admission process is reported schematically and then explained in every single point. For the accommodation assignment it is necessary to complete the entire process:



Verify the admission requirements and send the application

1) ADMISSION REQUEST

- Fill in the self-declaration form «Application for Admission» - Annex 1 to the Notice which can be downloaded from the website www.fondazionezanotti.org
- It is necessary to attach to the application for admission a paper (paper or video) in which the student expresses the reasons and motivation that led to the choice of the Campus Santa Teresa.
- It is possible to attach language certifications and any other document that will be taken into consideration in support of the application for admission and will be subject to evaluation by the Commission.
- The application for admission is considered valid only if complete in all its parts and accompanied by the required attachments.

The completed and signed form, complete with attachments, must be sent to campussantateresa@fondazionezanotti.org by Monday 25 August 2025.

2) EVALUATION INTERVIEW

- The student will be contacted to define the appointment time for the evaluation interview. The interview will take place on the pre-established dates. The modality of conduction (in person or online) will be agreed with the student. In case of an in-person interview, it will be possible to visit the facility. In case of an online interview, a visit must be scheduled no later than the day of the interview.
- The interview is mandatory, under penalty of exclusion from the ranking.

3. RANKING PROCESSING

The examining commission nominated by the Enrico Zanotti Foundation has a total of 100 points; in the formulation of the ranking, scores will be assigned based on:

- Evaluation interview (50 points)
- Paper which highlights the student's reasons and motivations for accessing Campus Santa Teresa (10 points)
- Qualifications such as the State Exam score, university curriculum and arithmetic average, CFU obtained, in addition to the certifications or certificates attached to the application (40 points).

The candidate's motivation for choosing university, scholastic/academic path and aptitude for community life, as well as interest in the cultural offering of the Campus, contribute to the evaluation of the interview and the essay.

To students who reconfirm their desire to remain within the structure for the subsequent academic year and who have distinguished themselves with a meritorious educational or training path, can be awarded up to 5 points.

The Commission will communicate the results through the publications of the rankings on the website www.fondazionezanotti.org, assigning the accommodation place until availability is exhausted.

Students "admitted NOT assigned" will remain in the ranking and will be contacted in the event of new availability.

4. ACCEPTANCE OF ACCOMMODATION

The student who is an "admitted assignee" will be contacted by the Enrico Zanotti Foundation to finalize the acceptance of the accommodation place.

The assigned student will receive the booking form relating to the assigned accommodation via email, which must be signed and sent to campussantateresa@fondazionezanotti.org within the times indicated by the Zanotti Foundation.

It is specified that acceptance of the accommodation will become effective upon signature of said form and related crediting of the non-interest-bearing deposit amount.

The Foundation reserves the right to carry out random checks regarding the veracity of the documentation presented upon admission. False declarations or failure to pay the deposit will result in the loss of the accommodation place and the scrolling of the ranking. Assigned students who are unable to accept the accommodation will be able to agree on different acceptance deadlines, if places are available.

SUPPORTED STUDENTS

N.2 accommodation places are intended for capable and meritorious students, even if without means (Supported Students), for whom special rates are envisaged, as detailed below:

- Reduction of € 50/month for capable and meritorious students who declare an ISEE of less than € 15,000

The ISEE requirement for eligibility is to be self-declared when applying for admission (specific ISEE for benefits for the right to University study).

The assignment of places reserved for Supported Students will be based on the ranking criteria described in section 3.

FOREIGN STUDENTS

N.2 accommodation places are reserved for Foreign Students.

The assignment of places reserved for Foreign Students will be based on the ranking criteria described in section 3.

FEES

The rooms are fully furnished doubles and singles, all with a shared bathroom for three guests. Contracts have a duration of 12 months and a deposit of € 400 is required.

The fees set out below are per person and include not only the allocation of the room, but also all utilities, accessory charges related to the running of the Campus and the activities linked to the 'Educational Project', as well as the use of the spaces and services provided under 'AREAS' and 'SERVICES'.

CONTRACT

The relationship between the Enrico Zanotti Foundation and each admitted student will be regulated by an annual contract and will allow them to take advantage of tax deductions in accordance with current regulations (art. 1, paragraph 208, Law no. 204/2007 – Financial Law 2008)

The contract will be signed together with the Educational Project and the Structure Regulations.

If the assigned student does not formalize the assignment of the accommodation place with a contract, he will lose the booking confirmation deposit.

TRUTH OF THE STATEMENTS

All the information indicated in the Application for Admission is to be considered self-declaration and therefore the declarant is responsible for the declarations made and forfeits the benefits obtained if the untruthfulness of the content of the same emerges. Untrue statements are punished pursuant to the Penal Code and special laws on the matter (art. 75 and 76 Presidential Decree of 28 December 2000, n. 445). Fondazione Zanotti, in turn, with the means at its disposal, will be able to carry out checks on the declarations produced, reserving, where necessary, the right to request additional documentation.
