Academic year Competition notice 2023 - 2024



The Enrico Zanotti Foundation has been active since 2001 in the training of young people in the field of University and Research, and operates in particular through the creation and educational management of university campuses, intended for off-campus university students and for faculty, researchers and postgraduates.

The Foundation counts among its purposes (Art. 3 of the Statute):

- a) The support and development of the educational and training process of young people in schools and universities, through the creation of synergies with the people and institutions that are involved in this process;
- b) Assistance to students through hosting services and facilities;
- c) Research and experimentation related to the inclusion of young people in active life;

For the Academic Year 2023/2024, the Foundation will have at its disposal the Santa Teresa Campus located in Ferrara, Piazzetta Giovanni da Tossignano 2.

The accommodations advertised are available to Italian and foreign university students, doctoral students and postgraduates (hereinafter only «Students»).


The current competition notice provides for the pre-emption of 1 place for foreign students.

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AREAS

The facility offers single and double rooms; the Santa Teresa Campus has outdoor and indoor common areas that allow students to live in an environment that fosters conviviality and socialization. At the same time, it offers private spaces for study and rest.

Common kitchens	3 communal kitchens for the preparation of meals proportioned based on the number of places made available by the structure

Multipurpose room	1 cultural and recreational area (equipped with audio-video equipment)
Outdoor areas	2 outdoor gardens located within the property. The areas are available for convivial, socializing and study activities. One of the gardens is located inside the Cloister. There is a large terrace that can be used to study or as a refreshment area.


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TRAINING PROJECT

The Santa Teresa Campus enriches the university study path with a 50-hour training project signed by the student at the beginning of the Academic Year. On Campus, the growth path is developed in an international environment conducive to study, in an atmosphere of confrontation and freedom. All of this is fostered by an ongoing training relationship with faculty from international backgrounds and tutors who will accompany the student both in the area of in-depth scientific study and in the introduction to the world of work. This model is designed together with each student and will synergistically propose thematic meetings and personalized paths so that each student can discover skills and potential in a way that is consistent with the chosen curriculum and appropriate to university commitments. The thematic meetings are part of the "ACCADEMIA - With Undivided Heart" project (https://www.fondazionezanotti.org/education/accademia/), which offers a structured, modular and open pathway composed of interdisciplinary courses and thematic in-depth studies with professors and personalities of national and international prominence capable of generating relationships and knowledge aimed at broadening the participants' horizons. The path will be monitored together with the tutors through interviews carried out during the stay on the Santa Teresa Campus. Thanks to collaborations with national and international organizations and institutions, the student is placed in a broad context that generates opportunities.

FEES

The rooms are both double and single and are equipped with a single bed, closet, bedside table, and bookshelves for texts (there are additional closets in the common areas available to students for seasonal changes). 12-month contracts (from 02/10/2023 to 25/09/2024);

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS


Italian and foreign students who:

- Are enrolled in any school or college-level institution for the Academic Year 2023/2024;
- Have passed the secondary school state examination;
- Can show documentation of any degree program already attended, with a list of exams taken and their grades with credits obtained;
- Can exhibit the certificate of a bachelor's/master's degree or a single-cycle degree, if already obtained;
- Have completed the application for admission (Annex 1) and passed the admission procedure
- Have no criminal convictions and no pending charges
- Have no illnesses incompatible with community life

Lack of one or more requirements will result in the inadmissibility of the application for admission

ADMISSION

The admission process is outlined and then explained at each point. The entire process must be completed for housing assignment:



1. REQUEST FOR ADMISSION

Application for admission is made by:

- Filling out the "Application for Admission" form Annex 1 to the Notice which can be downloaded from www.fondazionezanotti.org;
- Sending the completed form to campussantateresa@fondazionezanotti.org;
- Attaching to the application for admission an essay (paper or video) in which the student expresses the reasons and motivations that led him/her to choose the Saint Teresa Campu;
- You may attach any other documents (certifications, certificates, etc.) that will be considered in support of the application for admission and will be evaluated by the Committee

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2. INTERVIEW

The student will be contacted to set an appointment (date and time) in which to schedule the interview that competes for the allocation of the housing place. The mode of the interview will be agreed with the student and will take place online. The interview is mandatory, under penalty of exclusion from the ranking.

3. PUBLICATION OF THE RANKING LIST

The committee appointed by the Enrico Zanotti Foundation will notify the outcome of the ranking list to the individual participants by e-mail and by publication on the website www.fondazionezanotti.org by 06/10/2023, assigning the housing place until availability is exhausted.

Applications received after 04/10/2023 will be evaluated only in case of a subsequent announcement and if there are still places available once the ranking list is processed.

4. CONFIRMATION OF ACCOMMODATION

The eligible student will be contacted by Enrico Zanotti Foundation staff to finalize the acceptance of the accommodation. Please note that the acceptance of the accommodation will become effective with the signing of the accommodation reservation form and the related crediting of the amount of the non-interest bearing security deposit. The Foundation reserves the right to conduct spot checks on the truthfulness of the documentation submitted at the time of admission. False statements or failure to pay the deposit will result in the loss of the housing place and the sliding of the ranking list. Assigned students who are unable to accept housing may agree on different deadlines for acceptance if places are available. For the purposes of preparing the accommodation reservation, student assignees should send the following documents according to the timelines indicated by the staff of the Enrico Zanotti Foundation:

- Copy of a valid identity document;
- For students enrolled in the first year of University: copy of the certificate of passing
 the secondary school state exam with corresponding grade. If it is impossible to find
 the document within the timeframe of the notice, it will be possible to submit a selfcertification that will be supplemented later;
- For students enrolled at the University in years subsequent to the first: copy of the
 certificate of exams taken with related dates and gradesIn the case of a student already
 in possession of a bachelor's degree: copy of the degree certificate. If it is impossible to
 find the document within the timeframe of the announcement, it will be possible to
 submit a self-certification that will be supplemented later

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DOCUMENTATION

Accommodation acceptance forms and contracts will be sent to students via e-mail by staff following the announcement of the ranking results to those who are successful.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The Examination Committee has a total of 100 points to be awarded to students participating in the call for applications. In formulating the ranking list, scores will be awarded based on:

- Interview
- Essay highlighting the student's reasons and motivations for entering the St. Teresa Campus
- The State Examination score or weighted average communicated in the application for admission, in addition to the attached certifications or attestations, are a merit qualification.

CONTRACT

The relationship between the Enrico Zanotti Foundation and each admitted student will be governed by an annual contract and will allow them to take advantage of tax deductions according to current regulations (Art. 1, paragraph 208, Law No. 204/2007 - 2008 Budget Law). The contract will be signed together with the Educational Plan and Facility Regulations in October 2023.

If the student who is assigned the housing place does not formalize the housing place assignment with a contract, he/she will lose the deposit of the booking confirmation.
